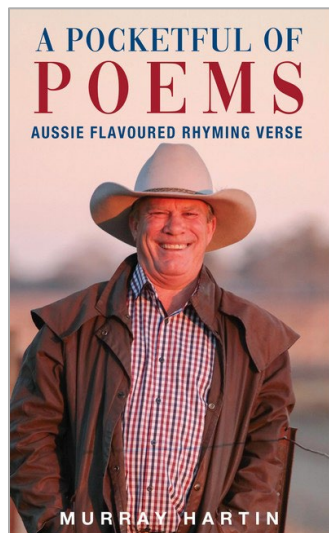
Johnny James and Other Verses

The poems chronicle their courtship and marriage, detailing his transformation from a violent gang to a contented husband and father.

The Glugs of Gosh is a book of satirical verse published by Angus & Robertson in 1917. The book's 13 poems are vignettes of life in a fictional kingdom called Gosh, inhabited by an arboreal race known as Glugs. Written in the style of children's nonsense poetry, the work attacks free trade, social conformity, intellectual cowardice and rampant bureaucracy.
