ROCKY CAPE WALKS

North Cave (900m return; start 200m south of the lighthouse) is a crevice in the rocks that sheltered generations of Aboriginal families. This short track leads through heath to a viewing platform with interpretive information. **South Cave** (300m return; start near the Burgess Cove boat ramp) was possibly abandoned once debris raised the ground level too high.

pinmatik/Rocky Cape circuit (up to 10km loop; start on Rocky Cape Rd near the turnoff to Burgess Cove) involves an ascent to **Tinkers Lookout** for a grand view over the cape, then a stroll down the heath-covered Blandfordia Spur towards the coast. A detour to the ravishing cove of **Cathedral Rock** is worthwhile before returning along the Coastal Route to Postmans Pass.

Banksia Grove Circuit (2.7km circuit; start at Sisters Beach boat ramp) takes you along the back of the Sisters Beach to a footpad that climbs past **Wet Cave** and detours to the more substantial **Lee Archer Cave** overlooking rugged coast. Stroll through Banksia Grove and then head south to curl back down to Sisters Beach.

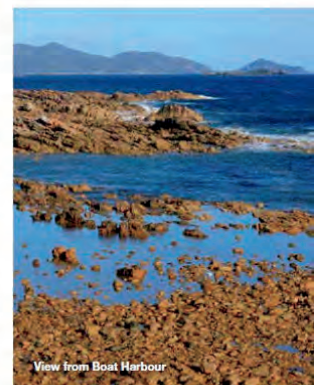
Postmans Track (6.5km one-way) was a horseback trail linking Sisters Beach and Boat Harbour. Arrange a car either end or double the distance for a return walk.



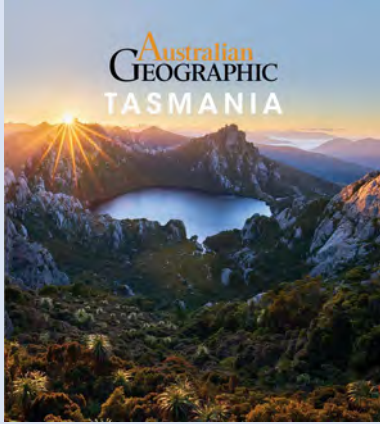

A GREAT NIGHT'S SLEEP

WHILE THERE'S NO CAMPING within the national park, two basic PWS campsites in **Peggs Beach Conservation Area** (west towards Stanley) provide a great beach setting for a minimal fee; no bookings taken. East of Rocky Cape, **Boat Harbour Beach Holiday Park** offers sites for vans or tents, as well as several glamorous cottages. You'll find plenty of holiday cottages elsewhere in charming Boat Harbour, and several in Sisters Beach. A short way inland, there's a warm welcome and hearty breakfast at **Eagle's Roost Farmstay B&B**, complete with wildlife-filled forest. Or try glamping among the trees with sea views on a large bush property at **Sandridge Estate**.
