The walk up to Boronia Peak, the eastern peak directly above Hells Gap, provides unparalleled views back to the stark geology and rock formations of the Wonderland Range as well as open vistas across the eastern plains and lakes outside the National Park. Starting from the Boronia Visitor Centre, the walk meanders beside Fyres Creek and then winds steadily up the hill, through broad slopes which attract large numbers of birds (including flocks of Gang gang cockatoos if you are lucky). The track crosses the ridgeline back and forth and finally breaks out into a last short scramble to the exposed rock ridge and trig point, which feels like the top of the world with its 360° view.
